Instructions for abstracts

400 words maximum. Structured and unstructured abstracts are both acceptable. Include: **Title**, **Name(s)**, **Affiliation**, **address**, **e-mail**, **phone**, **fax**. Submit electronically as an attachment as .doc, .wpd, .rtf or other acceptable file.

Instructions for posters

Instead of a short oral paper, a poster may be a very effective means of scientific communication and an easy way to get in contact with colleagues interested in the same subject.

To ensure the interest for these sessions, poster boards will be placed in a dedicated room and posters will be displayed on Friday 13 October and Saturday 14 October from 9.00 to 18.00.

When preparing a poster, please keep in mind the following:

- the maximum height of the poster is 120 cm and its maximum width is 80 cm.
- First, put the title of the poster in large capitals.
- Next, mention the names of the author(s) together with a full address for correspondence.
- Then, divide the poster into foru parts:
- (1) purpose: summarize the basic ideas or hypotheses which have guided you in your project
- (2) method: briefly describe subjects (patients, controls) and instruments
- (3) results: stress the important results and present data in small tables or preferably in a graphic way
- (4) conclusions: discuss the most important findings with their implications for further research or clinical/therapeutic practice.
- at the bottom of the poster panel you may put a large sheet of paper with the invitation "Please leave your name and address here, so we can send you more information"; you can also bring copies of your contribution (handouts, reprints) and leave them with the invitation "please take a copy".



We wish to stimulate presentations, discussions through symposia, papers and posters on adolescence and medical education. We wish to emphasize the development of resilience epistemology and interactionism.
