This conference aims to emphasize the urgent need to introduce into medical education worldwide Person-Cntered Medicine, the epochal epistemological indeterministic change of the Medicine paradigm , well explained by the change of basic science, which has overcome the current wrong and obsolete deterministic-mechanistic-biological or psychological paradigm of Medicine based on linear causality with the teaching of the correct interactionist paradigm-teleonomic changing the clinical method in accordance with the indeterministic-interactionist change of human nature and the relativity of the concept of health centered on the quality of the person. We have to remember Socrates who first substituted the knowledge object “What” with “Who” as subject of health, the principal revolution of the Person-Centered Medicine, Prevention and clinical method. This Greek philosophy-induced epistemological revolution, based on the birth of the human nature concept, was realised by the ethical-epistemological person-centered institution of the “Taking care of ” of the whole person, introduced by Jesus Christ, with the “ Good Samaritain” parable, root of the hospitals’ foundation and the nursing, fundament of the birth of clinical medicine, because of the cognitive elaboration of the patients’ death’s mourning,⁴ and complementary to the Greek concept of “Therapy”, based on the natural laws knowledge, (Democedes-Croton-Italy 600 AC (Magna Grecia)- Hippocrates 300 AC), the official birth of Medicine as medical science completed by the positivistic birth of the experimental medicine (Claude Bernard). To date Medicine cannot separate truth, love, freedom, responsibility, quality of existential choices inducing life style, from health and clinical method in the doctor-patient relationship, because of the human nature interdependence on the multidimensional interaction of variables belonging to subjectivity, biology, the relationship’s possibility and quality of the interaction with the interpersonal and physical environment.⁵ The result is the perception quality of the transcendent human dignity naturally addressed to search for being a human person (natural teleonomy) or non-perception of it, if the patient is only seen as fragmented object of knowledge and/or technique with the loss of the Medicine and health objective meaning.
