# Introduction

The Person Centered Medicine International Academy (PCMIA) and the Milan School of Medicine of the University Ambrosiana, in cooperation with the International Network for Person Centered Medicine, are engaged in a global diffusion of the Person Centered Medicine paradigm change in Medical Education and Research.
